### PROJECT PROFILE:

#### Conservation Planning Atlas



This year, the NPLCC launched its Conservation Planning Atlas (CPA), an online platform that allows users to discover, visualize and analyze landscape-scale data. The tool provides users the ability to search for spatial data sets, view results of NPLCC-funded projects, and learn more about landscape-scale conservation science and design in the region.

- » The CPA provides data sets organized by topics such as coastal, marine, freshwater, terrestrial, and anadromous resources with an additional gallery focused on climate change data.
- » The CPA is easily accessible and provides tools for collaboration. It can be used to create groups, to search and share data sets, and collaboratively visualize map products.

The NPLCC provides continuous outreach encouraging current and new users to explore the CPA, contribute to the vast array of content, and join the NPLCC in cultivating a one-stop-shop for landscape data in the North Pacific Region and beyond.
